Loop Induction – TALBOT CAMPUS

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

What to do if you need to use the loop

1. Go to the Computer and Equipment Help Desk (based in the Library)
2. Discuss your needs with a member of staff who will loan you equipment to suit your needs.



- This could be either a red necklace or black headphone set.
- The red necklace is used in conjunction with the loop system and a hearing aid.
- The black headphone is used independently for people who do not have hearing aids but are hard of hearing.

Operating instructions

1. The Sennheiser symbol sign should be facing upwards.
2. Switch on and adjust the volume
3. If you are using the loop system you will need to set your hearing aid to T.

Useful Information

You can negotiate loans for one off use or for the entire term. If you loan the equipment on a long term basis the batteries will need to be recharged regularly.

- It is a good idea to arrange a time to meet with your tutor before the planned lectures. You could use this opportunity to address any concerns you may have. The tutor will also become aware of your needs and can make preparations to use the induction loop.
