Welcome to Bournemouth University

Campus tours (approximately 30 minutes)

Campus tours run continuously throughout the day. This includes a look inside our skills labs in Studland House. Please meet our student ambassadors at the campus tour desk in the Exhibition Hall on the Ground Floor of Bournemouth House.

Bus tours of Bournemouth and accommodation (approximately one hour)

Join our guided tour of the town centre, seafront, Talbot Campus and get an outside view of UniLet accommodation. You will also have the opportunity to look inside Cranborne and Purbeck House halls of residence. Collect your free tickets from the campus tour desk in the Exhibition Hall. Buses depart from the bus stop outside Bournemouth House at 11.15am and 1.15pm. Tickets are limited so please collect early to avoid disappointment.

Shuttle bus service from Travel Interchange/train station

Please use our free bus service from the Travel Interchange to the Lansdowne Campus. Student ambassadors will meet you at the station at 9.30am, 10am and 10.30am. The return journey will depart at 3.40pm and 4.20pm from the bus stop outside Bournemouth House.

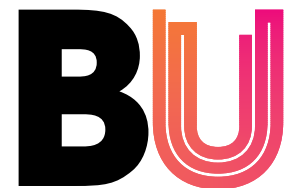

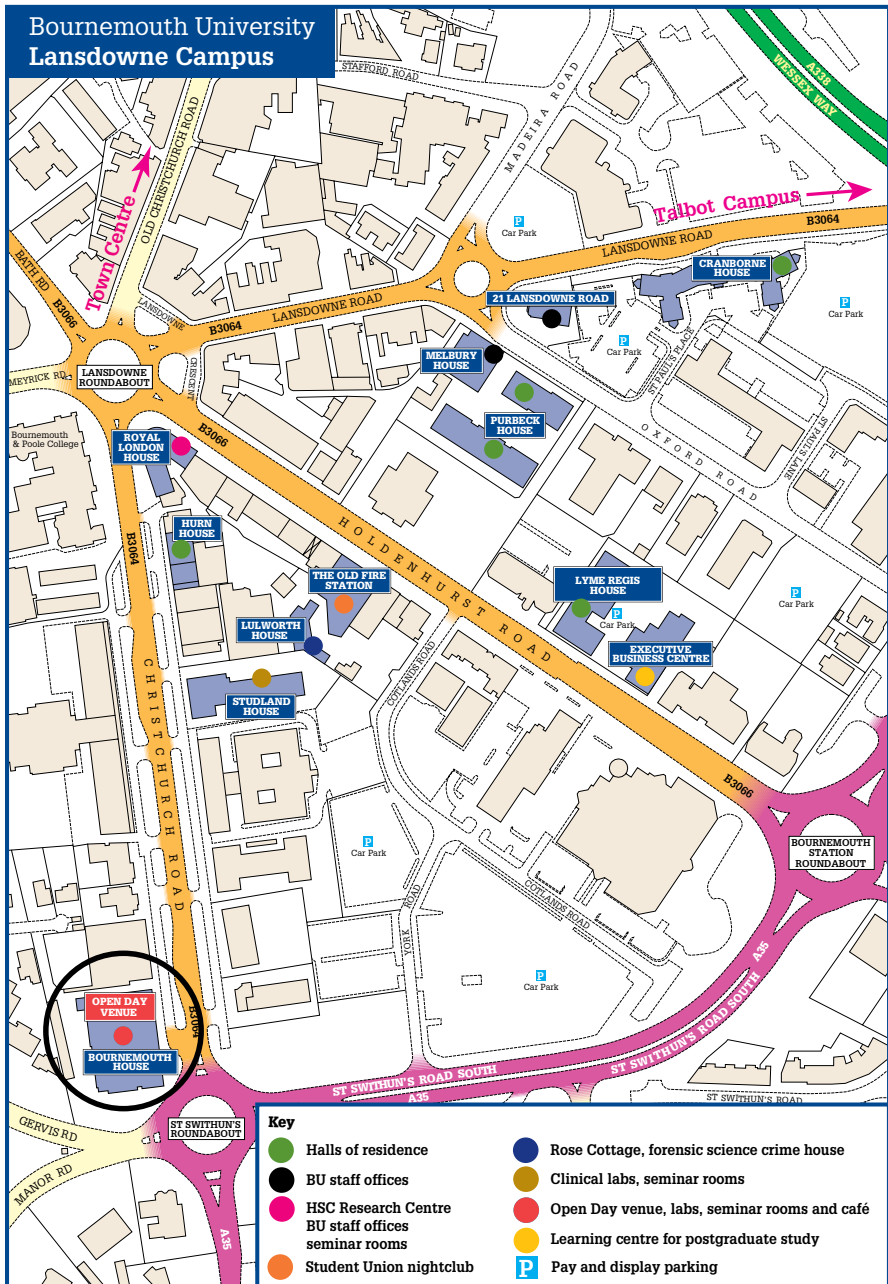
