Welcome to Bournemouth University

This is your chance to discover what it is like to be a BU student. We encourage you to attend course talks, explore the Talbot Campus and the local area and ask lots of questions to the many staff and students you will meet.

Check-in (open from 10am)

Upon arrival please visit our check-in desks in Poole House or Weymouth House receptions. You can follow signs and ask our student ambassadors (in the pink T-shirts) to direct you to the check-in desks, where you will be given a welcome pack.

Lost? Confused?

Please visit the Information Point in the Sports Hall with any queries or ask a student ambassador.

We offer three different types of tours:

Campus tours (approximately 30 minutes)

Campus tours run continuously throughout the day (booking is not necessary). It will include a look inside the Student Village, our on-campus accommodation, so please meet our student guides in Poole House Reception.

Bus tours of Bournemouth (approximately 30 minutes)

Join our guided tour of the town centre, seafront, Lansdowne Campus and get an outside view of UniLet accommodation. Tickets are free and available from the Information Point in the Sports Hall (tickets are restricted to one guest per student). Buses depart at 12.30pm, 1.30pm and 2.30pm, from the bus stop at the entrance of the University.

Accommodation tours (approximately 45 minutes)

Take the opportunity to see inside our student accommodation. The Student Village, our on-campus accommodation, can be toured during the campus tours (see above). If you would also like to visit Cranborne House and Purbeck House we have buses departing from the bus stop at the entrance of the University at 12pm, 1.30pm, 2.30pm and 3pm (tickets are limited and restricted to one guest per student). Collect your free tickets from the Information Point in the Sports Hall. A student guide will meet you at the halls of residence.

Shuttle bus service from Travel Interchange/train station

Please use our free bus service from the Travel Interchange to the Talbot Campus. Student ambassadors will meet you at the station at 9.30am, 10am and 10.30am. The return journey will depart at 3.30pm and 4.10pm from the bus stop at the entrance to the University.

The Sir Michael Cobham Library/ Additional Learning Needs

On your campus tour you will have chance to visit our award winning library and find out about the resources we have to offer. The Additional Learning Needs team will also be on hand to discuss the individual support BU can offer you.

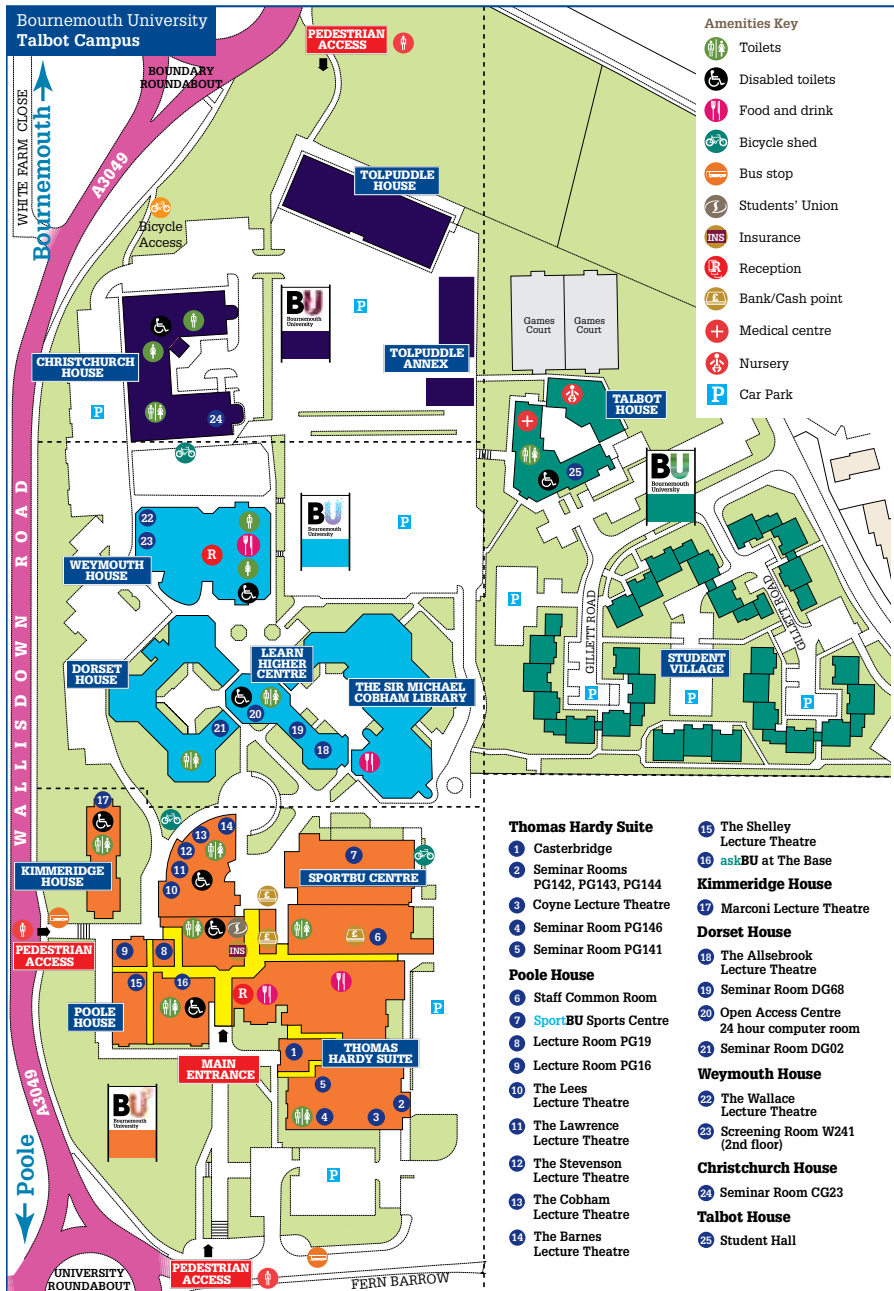
