Music Scholarships

1. Guidelines

The following are a summary of the criteria that apply to the Music Scholarship. Full details are available on our website (www.bournemouth.ac.uk/scholarships)

Applicants must:

- Be liable to pay fees at the UK/EU rate
- Have received and accepted an offer of a place on the first year of an Undergraduate Bournemouth University course or of a Bournemouth University-validated course at one of the University's Partner Colleges
- Be a talented instrumentalist or vocalist wishing to continue to develop musically as well as academically. Normally, the applicant will be expected to have reached at least the Associated Board Grade VIII, or the equivalent level, and to have been involved in ensemble activity.

2. Exceptions

- Non EU nationals. Such applicants are subject to separate funding and Scholarship arrangements and are therefore not eligible to apply;
- Applicants may apply for more than one Scholarship, but if successful in more than one category, only one award can be made;
- Only those students being funded under the 'new style' arrangements may apply for the award i.e. those students who are paying the new higher tuition fee.

3. Selection Process

- Completed application forms should be returned to **askBU Students Service**, Bournemouth University, The Base, Poole House, Fern Barrow, Poole, BH12 5BB, UK. Forms can also be scanned and emailed to **askBU Students Service** (askBUstudents@bournemouth.ac.uk)
- Shortlisted applicants may be invited to interview and/or audition. The deadline for applications is 31 July prior to the start of the course although late applications may be accepted if there are funds remaining.

4. Conditions for the Continuation of a Music Scholarship into Subsequent Levels of the Scholar's Programme of Study

Where relevant, and in order for a Scholarship to be renewed for the subsequent level of the course of study, Scholars in receipt of a Music Scholarship will be expected to:

- Have been actively involved in their course of study and to have participated in such student feedback activity as is required by the Programme Leader
- Have met the academic progression requirements for entry to the subsequent level of the course
- Have been actively involved in developing their musical interests through participation in the University's musical activities, including membership of the University Choir and/or other University musical ensembles, as appropriate, and through performance at concerts, etc
- Re-enrol for the subsequent level of the course and continue to actively participate in that programme as well as in appropriate music related events at the University.
