



1. Criteria

The following are a summary of the criteria that apply to the Sports Scholarship. Full details are available on our website (www.bournemouth.ac.uk/scholarships)

Applicants must:

- Be liable to pay fees at the UK/EU rate
- Have received and accepted an offer of a place on the first year of an Undergraduate Bournemouth University course or on a Bournemouth University validated course at one of the University's Partner Colleges
- Be a talented sportsperson and have the desire to continue to develop in the sporting arena as well as academically. Normally, the applicant will be expected to be representing their sport at national or junior international level or be able to demonstrate the potential to compete at these levels.

2. Exceptions

- Non-EU nationals. Such applicants are subject to separate funding and Scholarship arrangements and are not eligible to apply
- Applicants may apply for more than one Scholarship, but if successful in more than one category, only one award can be made
- Only those students being funded under the 'new style' arrangements may apply for the award ie. those students who are paying the new higher tuition fee.

3. Selection process

- Completed application forms should be returned to **askBU Students Service**, Bournemouth University, The Base, Poole House, Fern Barrow, Poole, BH12 5BB,UK. Forms can also be scanned and emailed to askBUstudents@bournemouth.ac.uk
- Applications must be accompanied by a sealed sporting reference from a high performance coach or National Governing Body
- Shortlisted applicants may be invited for interview
- In each academic year applicants will be ranked on merit, as determined by **sportBU**, on the basis of the above information as well as on current performance and on evidence of commitment and determination to succeed
- The deadline for applications is 31 July prior to the start of the course although late applications may be accepted if there are funds remaining.

4. Conditions for the continuation of a Sport Scholarship into subsequent levels of the scholar's courses of study

Where relevant, and in order for a Scholarship to be renewed for the subsequent level of the programme of study, scholars in receipt of a Sport Scholarship will be expected to:

- Have been actively involved in their course of study and to have participated in such student feedback activity as is required by the Programme Leader
- Have met the academic progression requirements for entry to the subsequent level of the course
- Have been actively involved in developing their sporting interests through participation in the sporting life of the University, including the University's EXCEL Sports Programme, and by representing the University at appropriate sporting event(s)
- Re-enrol for the subsequent level of the course and continue to actively participate in that course as well as in appropriate sporting events as determined by the University.
