Undergraduate International Scholarships

1. Guidelines

The following are a summary of the criteria that apply to BU's Undergraduate International Scholarships. Full details are available on our website (www.bournemouth.ac.uk/scholarships).

Applicants must:

- Be liable to pay fees at the International (non-EU) rate
- Have received and accepted an offer of a place on the first year of a Bournemouth University undergraduate course within the following Schools (except for the courses listed at 2. below):
 - The Business School
 - School of Design, Engineering & Computing
 - The Media School
 - School of Tourism
- Be able to demonstrate an outstanding academic profile relevant to your course. An outstanding academic profile is one which is considered to be the equivalent to 3 Grade A's at UK 'A' Level as assessed by NARIC at www.naric.org, the national agency responsible for providing advice on international qualifications.

2. Exceptions

- Applicants may apply for more than one Scholarship, but if successful in more than one category, only one award can be made
- Applicants for courses delivered at Partner Institutions are not eligible for this scholarship
- Applicants for Top-up courses are not eligible for the scholarship
- Financial need will not be taken into consideration
- Applicants on the following courses are not eligible to apply for this scholarship. Please see the section on the BU website regarding available Scholarships for these courses

3. Application for, and confirmation of, BU Undergraduate International Scholarship

- The deadline for applications is 31 July prior to the start of your course
- BU will advise you as soon as possible after the deadline whether your application is successful and the award will be confirmed once you have your grades and the offer has been confirmed.
