

Exporting to EndNote® from BU Library Catalogue

1. THE SCOPE OF THIS GUIDE

Exporting from online databases into your EndNote Library is a key feature of EndNote, and a quick and efficient way to build your Endnote Library. This guide takes you through exporting from the **Bournemouth University Library Catalogue**.

2. EXPORTING FROM BU LIBRARY CATALOGUE

After you have completed your search on the catalogue follow these steps:

BU Bournemouth University
Search your library catalogue...

Search: western films [Search] More search options

Catalogue Search for "western films"

Add The Western to list

Click on save

Each item can then be either saved to an existing list, or a new list, or exported directly to Endnote

If you have saved them as a list then the list can be exported to Endnote

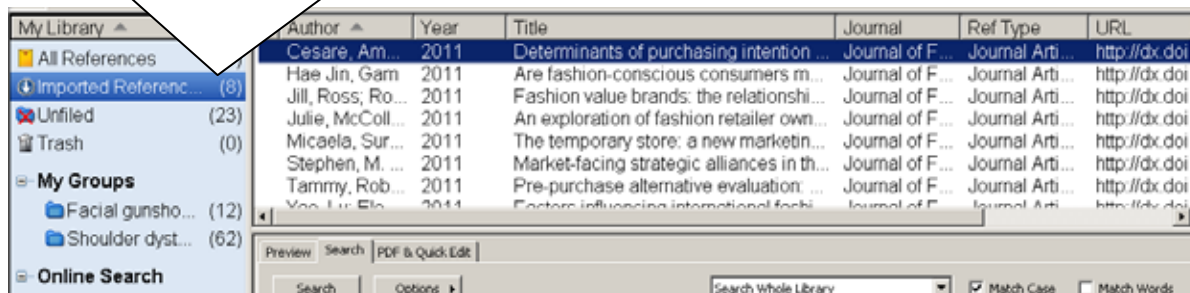
