

Exporting to EndNote® from BURO

1. THE SCOPE OF THIS GUIDE

Exporting from online databases into your EndNote Library is a key feature of EndNote, and a quick and efficient way to build your Endnote Library. This guide takes you through exporting from **BURO (Bournemouth University Research Online)**.

2. EXPORTING FROM BURO

You cannot export directly from BURO to Endnote. You have to export your references to a file and then import them into Endnote.

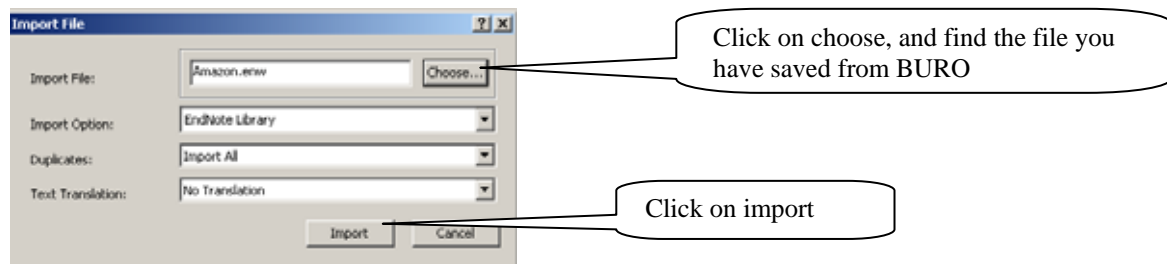
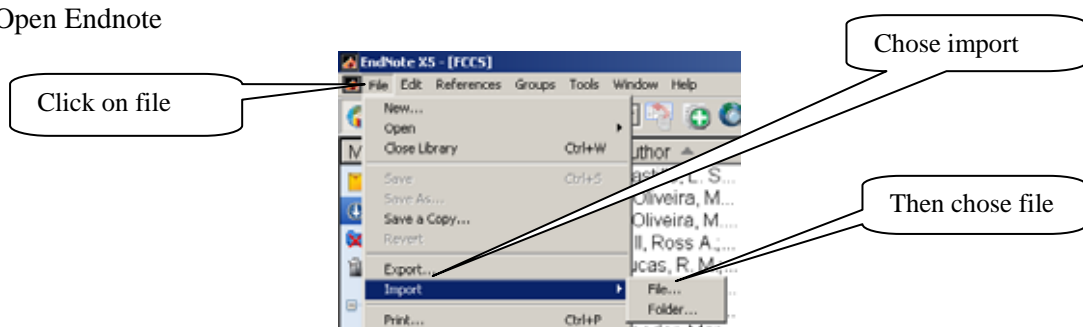
After you have completed your search on BURO follow these steps



When prompted save the file.

3. IMPORTING TO ENDNOTE

Open Endnote



Your references will appear in Endnote in Imported References and Unfiled.

Note: these instructions are for Microsoft Explorer. The procedures for Exporting to EndNote may vary in other browsers.
