

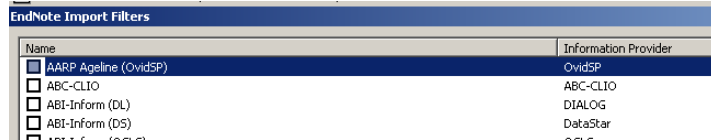
Adding an Import Filter to EndNote®

1. THE SCOPE OF THIS GUIDE

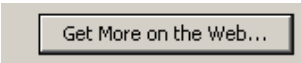
This guide explains how to add an EndNote filter, which enables you to Import from external databases.

2. HOW TO ADD AN IMPORT FILTER

- Check that the filter you want is not already available. Edit – Import Filters – Filter Manger



- If the database and platform you require is not there, click on



- This takes you through to <http://www.endnote.com/support/enfilters.asp>
This will give you a full list of the import filter available from EndNote, these can be sorted by Database, Information Provider or Date

- Chose the database whose filter you wish to download

- Choose the filter you wish to use and click on Download
When prompted choose save, in whichever version of Endnote you are using

- Save as Type = EndNote filter

- The filter will then appear in the Endnote filters
