

Exporting to EndNote® from OVID

1. THE SCOPE OF THIS GUIDE

Exporting from online databases into your EndNote Library is a key feature of EndNote, and a quick and efficient way to build your Endnote Library. This guide takes you through exporting from **OVID** which provides access to the following databases

- International Film Archive
- Journals @ovid
- Maternity and infant care

2. EXPORTING FROM OVID

You cannot export directly from BURO to Endnote. You have to export your references to a file and then import them into Endnote.

After you have completed your search on BURO follow these steps

Select the references you want

Click on Export,

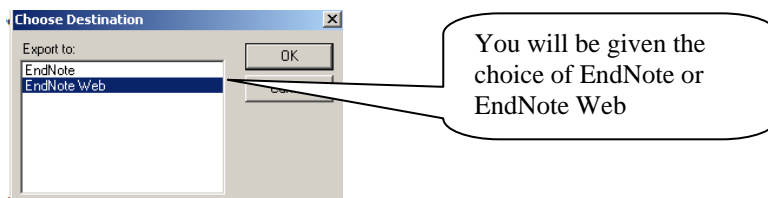

From the options in the dropdown box select EndNote

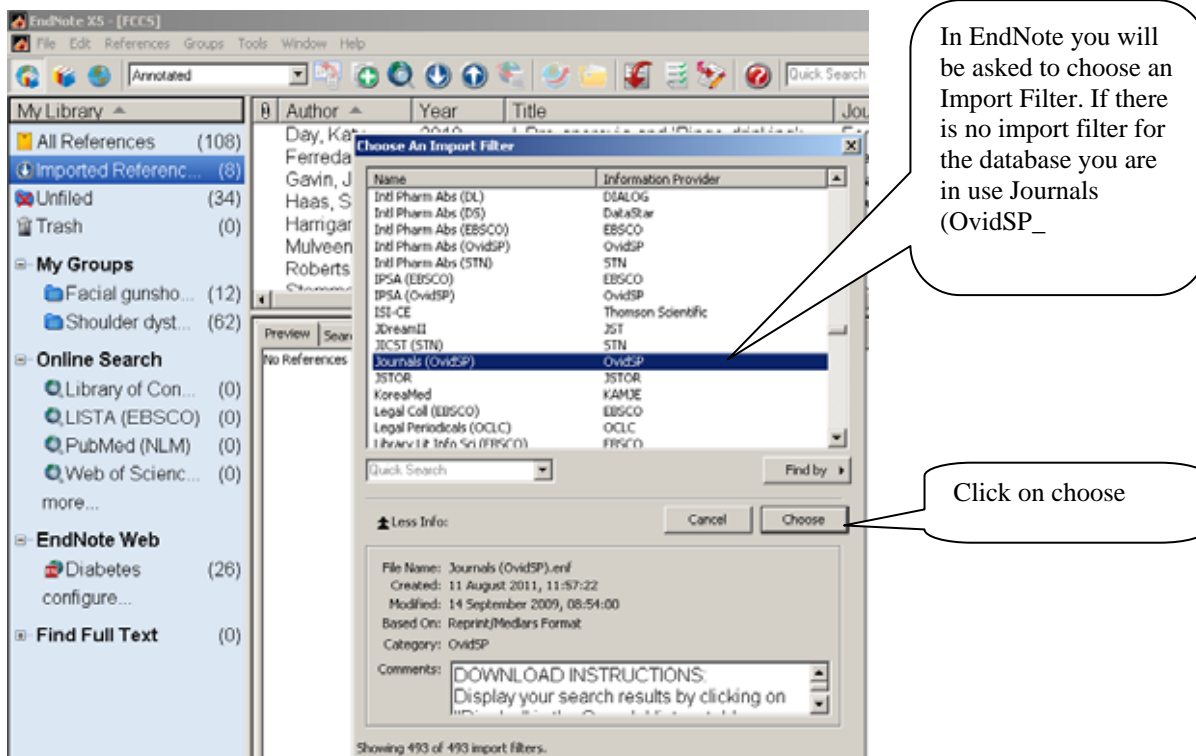
Choose the fields you want
