### **Additional Learning Needs**

Support for students with additional learning needs based at the Lansdowne Campus is provided by the additional learning needs service, abbreviated to ALN. This service is responsible for providing academic support to those with, for example, specific learning difficulties, mobility issues, sensory impairments, mental health issues, medical conditions such as diabetes or epilepsy, and, developmental disorders such as Asperger's Syndrome.
