NOTES

As well as contributing to the cost of tuition, the Tuition Fee also includes the basic cost of any compulsory activity students are required to undertake as part of their programme of study. However, students should make an appropriate allowance to cover discretionary costs such as printing, the purchase of textbooks, optional placements etc.

In 2008/09 the government decided to withdraw funding for students who are undertaking a qualification at an equal or lower level than one which they already hold. E.g. students who already have an MA or MSc and wish to take an MA or MSc in another subject will not be funded.
