Academic entry requirements

BU International College Foundation Certificates

You can undertake a Foundation Certificate before going on to an undergraduate course if you have successfully completed 12 years of schooling in India and achieved a minimum of UKVI IELTS (Academic) 5.0. Visit: www.bournemouth.ac.uk/internationalcollege

Undergraduate courses (Bachelor's degree)

You can apply to study a Bachelor's degree from year one if you hold a Higher Secondary School Certificate/Standard XII and have achieved an average percentage of at least 65% (although some courses will require this to be higher).

Postgraduate courses (Master's degree)

You need to have an Indian Bachelor's (Honours) degree from a recognised higher education institution in a relevant subject and to have met the minimum required grades.

Research programmes

You need a Master's degree to be considered for a BU research programme.

English entry requirements

Undergraduate and postgraduateIELTS Academic (UKVI or non-UKVI) 6.0 with a minimum of 5.5 in each component.



Receive an offer

BU aims to make you an offer within two weeks week of a fully completed application. Courses requiring additional selection measures such as interviews may take a little longer. You will be issued with a conditional offer (if you are still completing a qualification) or an unconditional offer (if you have met all entry requirements for your course)



Confirm your offer

To confirm your place at BU, you will need to accept your offer on myHub. You will also need to pay a deposit to secure your place if you are a non-EU applicant. If your offer is conditional, you will also need to upload any final documents required.



Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS)

International applicants will receive a request from BU asking for certain details (such as current passport) which are required to issue a CAS. Applicants who require a Student Route visa to study in the UK, will be issued a CAS once they have paid a deposit. CAS's are issued from three months before the course starts.
