## Fees

This table shows the range of annual tuition fees for 2021/22 entry for both undergraduate and postgraduate courses at BU. Payment can be made in full or in two instalments.

## Academic entry requirements

### BU International College Foundation Certificates

You can undertake a Foundation Certificate before going on to an undergraduate course if you have successfully completed 12 years of schooling in Nigeria and achieved a minimum of UKVI IELTS (Academic) 5.0.

### Undergraduate courses (Bachelor's degree)

You can apply to study a Bachelor's degree from year one if you hold an Ordinary National Diploma (OND/ND) Post-Secondary Certificate, or an Advanced National Technical Certificate (ANTC)/Advanced National Commercial Certificate (ANCC), subject to specific grades.

If your highest qualification is a West African Examinations Council (WAEC) Senior School Certificate, you will need to complete a one-year foundation course, such as the BU International College Foundation Certificate, before you can start a Bachelor's degree.

### Postgraduate courses (Master's degree)

You need to have a Bachelor's degree from a recognised higher education institution in Nigeria to apply for a postgraduate course at BU.

### Research programmes

You need a postgraduate degree to be considered for a BU research programme.

Some courses may require specific or additional entry requirements.

## English entry requirements

### Undergraduate and postgraduate

IELTS Academic (UKVI or non-UKVI) 6.0 with a minimum of 5.5 in each component.

Note: some courses may require a higher IELTS score.

In many cases, in place of a formal English test such as IELTS, you can submit a letter from your university confirming that you were taught in English (providing you graduated within the last 2 years) or a copy of your WAEC/NECO Year XII English score (provided the score was at least C6).

## Scholarships

### Undergraduate

We award a £2,500 Academic Excellence Scholarship to you automatically if you have achieved equivalent to AAA or above at A-level.

### Postgraduate

We award a £3,500 Academic Excellence Scholarship to you automatically if you have a Bachelor's degree from Nigeria with a GPA of 3.80/5.00 or equivalent.

# How to *apply*



## Accommodation

We offer a number of safe and modern rooms in our halls of residence for students to live in.

Prices range from £134 to £170 per week and most apartments come with five to six en-suite rooms, and a shared kitchen space. We also offer a limited number of studio rooms in our halls of residence, which are priced separately. Our halls are conveniently located near supermarkets and bus stops to enhance ease of access.

Halls of residence have weekly organised activities, common rooms to enjoy evenings with friends, and 24/7 support services. Accommodation is available for both September and January starters.

### 1 Prepare

#### Prepare your application documents

In order to make an application you will need to prepare the required documents. These include qualification transcripts and certificates, your personal statement, academic references, and your most recent English qualification. ### 2 Apply

#### Make your application to BU

### 3 Offer

#### Receive an offer

BU aims to make you an offer within two weeks of a fully completed application. Courses requiring additional selection measures such as interviews may take a little longer. You will be issued with a conditional offer (if you are still completing a qualification) or an unconditional offer (if you have met all entry requirements for your course).

### 4 Accept

#### Confirm your offer

To confirm your place at BU, you will need to accept your offer on myHub. You will also need to pay a deposit to secure your place if you are an international applicant. If your offer is conditional, you will also need to upload any final documents required.

### 5 Confirm

#### Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS)

International applicants will receive a request from BU asking for certain details (such as current passport) which are required to issue a CAS. Applicants who require a Student Route visa to study in the UK will be issued a CAS once they have paid a deposit. CAS are issued from six months before the course starts.
