



11-a-Side Campus League Terms and Conditions

(Amended 23/05/2018)

League Details

- Forms need to be completed and handed in by booking deadline dates available on Page 3 of the Electronic Booking Form (subject to availability). If all 20 spaces have been filled before this date/time then no more entries will be taken.
- Payment must be made at reception or over the phone prior to the registration form being completed. Link to the electronic form will be emailed to the captain upon the payment being received.
- The league begins the 17th October 2018 and will aim to run until the end of March although games may need to take place later

League Rules

- All players <u>MUST</u> be current students. No graduates or members of the community are permitted to play in the Campus League.
- Every week during term time, each team must be available to play one fixture excluding official exam periods.
- Any game that is cancelled due to conditions or unforeseen circumstances will be re- arranged or regarded as a draw.
- Any team unable to attend a fixture will hand the opposition a 3-0 victory and a 3 point deduction will be conceded at the discretion of the Campus Leagues Manager.
- If a team can field at least 8 players, they are expected to attend and play their game, otherwise a forfeit will be conceded.
- Teams must notify their opposition of a forfeit no later than the night before the scheduled match.
- If a team fails to notify their opposition of a forfeit and and fails to attend the game, this will result in an automatic 3 point deduction.
- Referees will be appointed to fixtures where possible and each team must provide a referee for a half if not.
- Each team must also provide a linesman. If unable, it falls on the opposition team to provide the second linesman.
- Performance Sport football players are not eligible to play in either the league or cup competitions and will result in a loss for the team fielding these players. If this happens more than once then further disciplinary action will be taken such as exclusion from the league.
- The winner of the league is the team at the top of the table after all league matches have been completed.
- The cup competition will begin after Christmas. This will be seeded based on league standings at the time of the cup draw in December (lower placed teams will play each other in first rounds and highest teams will be play each other in first rounds..)
- If at the end of the season teams are level on points, final standings will be based on Head to Head results.
- Rules that are not covered in the above are down to the discretion of the Campus League Manager, with BUCS Rules and Regulations used as guidance.

- Rules and general codes of conduct must be obeyed no matter what sport is being undertaken, failure to do so will result in disqualification of your team and/or players.
- SportBU has the right to remove any teams or players they feel are in breach of general standards of behaviour and conduct.
- Each team MUST have paid their entry fee in full in order to play in the league. Spot checks on player's eligibility will be undertaken at random times to avoid cheating. Players playing for more than one team will face disciplinary action as will the team.
- No refunds will be given after the team has registered unless SportBU cancel the leagues.
- Only SportBU can postpone or cancel any matches or fixtures, in the event of cancellation due to weather we will do our best to help re-arrange fixtures.
- SportBU reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Leagues.
- Any complaints or appeals on the day of the match must be given to the SportBU Leagues Manager.
- Match facilities must be respected by all players including using toilets on site and litter being cleared away. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action.
- All players understand the possibility of injury and accept all responsibility when playing in the Campus Leagues.

Things to Know - Bournemouth University Campus Sport

- SportBU Campus Sports Leagues and Tournaments must be played in a safe and appropriate manner. There will be zero tolerance for anything less
- Results and fixtures will be available from SportBU.
- Appropriate sportswear must be worn at all times. Only trainers and football boots must be worn, no jeans, flip flops or shoes.
- Please use the bins provided for litter. Please take care of the facilities you are using.

Additional Information

- Please note, registration must occur by the tournament deadline. Any applications received after the deadline will not be able to compete in the tournament.
- Matches have an allotted time. If you arrive late you MUST reduce your playing time. AT NO TIME DO YOU RUN OVER INTO SOME ONE ELSES TIME. The BU Match Coordinator's decision is final!
- Failure to report the score will result in the match being awarded a 0-0 draw.
- Once all teams have been registered, a league schedule will be





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available from SportBU and online in the first few weeks.

- The captain is responsible for the teams conduct.
- All players will allow photographs that maybe taken during fixtures to be used on BU promotional work.
