- September intake:
 - BSc (Hons) Adult Nursing
 - MSc Adult Nursing
 - BSc (Hons) Children's & Young People's Nursing
- 3 Years FT (BSc)
- 7 weeks Holiday each year (Christmas = 2 weeks; Easter = 2 weeks &
 - Summer = 3 weeks)
- Placements continue throughout the year (45 week year course)
- Theory completed in study blocks and study days
