

Collecting your Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) Tier 4 visa when you arrive in Bournemouth



If you have applied for a Tier 4 student visa from outside the UK, you will receive an Entry Clearance visa sticker in your passport. This visa will be valid for 30 days and you will need to travel to the UK during these dates.

Your application for a UK visa has been successful. This means that when you arrive in the UK you will have permission to enter as as _____ from _____ to _____.

What this means for you

Your passport / travel document contains your Visa, with which you can travel to the UK. Your Visa is valid for 30 days only. If you do not travel to the UK within this 30 day period, your Visa will expire and you will need to apply for a replacement Visa, the fee for which can be found online at <https://www.gov.uk/visa-fees>

What you must do when you arrive in the UK

The full details of your permission to stay in the UK will be on your Biometric Residence Permit (BRP). You must collect your BRP within 10 days of arriving in the UK from the following Post Office branch:

Your BRP will be available for collection from ignore this date

When you visit the collection point to obtain your BRP you must bring your passport / travel document containing the Visa. Please also bring this letter as it will help locate your BRP quickly.

If you do not collect your BRP within 10 days of arrival in the UK you may be subject to a financial penalty or a reduction or cancellation of your leave.

UK Visas and Immigration is an arm of the Home Office

When you receive your passport with this visa, you will also receive a letter from the Home Office. It is very important that you bring this letter with you to the UK. Once you arrive in Bournemouth, you will need to collect your Biometric Residence Permit (BRP), which is your visa for the duration of your studies at BU. This letter confirms the address your BRP has been delivered to.

Please ignore the date noted on the letter for when your BRP will be ready for collection and follow the dates below.

You will be able to collect your BRP at these times:
