Helping people live better for longer

- Our researchers in The Ageing & Dementia Research Centre are producing work that significantly impacts the theory, education, and professional practice in nutritional care for those with dementia.
- Based in our MRI Centre, the Institute of Medical Imaging and Visualisation supports high-quality research, with programmes including studies into liver, pancreatic and biliary diseases, brain conditions and diabetes.
- Our highly-regarded Orthopaedic Research Institute is helping people with hip arthritis to live pain-free lives through its



ground-breaking Cycling Against Hip Pain programme. Working alongside regional hospitals and healthcare partners, they are helping people to live healthier, independent lives.

Helping to protect and preserve a sustainable environment

• Our Institute for the Modelling of Socio-Environmental Transitions uses information on how past societies responded to

environmental change to explore the most sustainable options available to present-day societies in response to similar pressures.

- We are also focusing on finding ways of protecting and enhancing coastal ecosystems, specifically in ports and harbours, which are areas typically hostile to marine life.
- BU academics are working on projects to widen our knowledge of ecosystems. From capturing heathland data in the Purbecks to monitoring wild salmon in the River Frome, analysing microbes in UK rivers and much more.





Our campuses and facilities

Further information and next steps

We recommend that you consult a solicitor when making or amending your Will.

Depending on your preferences, there are several types of legacy to consider, including:

Residuary legacy*

The bequest of all or part of your net estate after other legacies and provisions have been made. You do not have to specify the sum you would like to leave.

Pecuniary legacy

This is a simple legacy of a specified sum of money.

Specific legacy**

A legacy in the form of shares or other assets such as property, valuables, stocks or other items that BU can sell.

Suggested/example wording for Will:

I give to Bournemouth University for its general purposes / for research / for student support / to enhance its physical facilities (please delete as appropriate).

The sum of______ (£______)

and I direct that the receipt of the Vice-Chancellor or other authorised officers of the said university shall be a sufficient discharge for my Executors / Trustees.

- * Whilst all types of legacy are valuable to the university, a Residuary legacy is less likely to be affected by inflation than other types, so it would be best placed to provide the support you intended at the time of writing your Will, thus maximising the value of your legacy.
- ** For advice on the wording required for specific legacies, we recommend you consult a solicitor.
