Virtual Internships

Start date: You will be given the choice of duration and start date to fit your schedule. Internship duration ranges from one to four months starting before 1 September 2021, with options for 10 to 30 hours per week for a minimum of 120 hours.



Scholarship fund: If successful the full cost of a remote internship with Virtual Internships will be covered by the Santander Scholarship.

As part of a global cohort of students you will work with a dedicated internship coach and career development expert. You'll attend global employability webinars and start working towards your Global Career Management Plan and Certification. Scholarship fund: If successful, the Santander Scholarship will offer a contribution of £870 towards a remote internship starting before 1 September 2021. Intern Abroad HQ

Start date: Customisable options to choose from including a 100-hour internship (three weeks full-time or five weeks part time)



Scholarship fund: Santander will fund scholarships for students who start before 1 September 2021. If successful, the scholarship will cover the cost of the 100-hour programme. Intern HQ also offers other options including a 250-hour internship (eight weeks full-time or 12 weeks part-time), for which the scholarship will fund a contribution up to £870; any additional costs would be your responsibility to pay.
