Admission requirements

Academic

- 2020 entry requirements 112 128 UCAS tariff points with a minimum of 2 A-levels or equivalent.
- Required subjects are detailed online.

Non-academic

- Drivers licence and emergency (blue light) training
- Enhanced DBS Check
- Occupational Health Check and Immunisations
- Experience in Healthcare



Admissions and selection process

- Currently offer 35 places
- This last year 700+ applicants (2020-21)
- The personal statement counts on application
- Relevant work experience needs to be quantified

Interview day will include

- Group Work
- Scenario based evaluations
- Face to face interviews (virtual)

Course structure at BU

- 3 years BSc (Hons)
- Full time (long semesters)
- Blended learning
- Over 2000 hours in practice
- Inter-professional education





The course

- Currently 675 placement hours per year: predominately with SWASFT or SCAS and at specialist teaching hospitals
- Roughly 50% time split between university and placement

- Approved by the Health & Care Professions Council (HCPC)
- Endorsed by the College of Paramedics.










College of Paramedics Career Framework 2018


