Use this guide to help you prepare and practise answering the types of questions you may be asked in your credibility interview.

About Your Course

- Why did you choose this course?
- What topics or modules will you be studying?
- How does this course relate to your previous studies?
- How will this qualification help with your future career?

About the University

- Why did you choose this university?
- What do you know about the university's facilities, reputation, or location?
- Did you consider other universities or countries? Why did you choose the UK?

Academic Background

- Can you describe your previous education?
- Are there any gaps in your studies? If yes, what did you do during that time?
- Why are you continuing your studies now?

English Language Skills

- What English qualification have you taken?
- How have you used English in your academic or work life?
- Are you confident studying in English?

Accommodation and Living Arrangements

- Where will you live in the UK?
- How did you arrange your accommodation?

Finances

- Who is funding your studies?
- How much will your tuition fees and living costs be?
- Can you explain any large deposits in your bank account?

Future Plans

- What do you plan to do after completing your course?
- Do you plan to return to your home country? Why?
- How will this course support your long-term career goals?

Tip: Practise answering these questions out loud in English. Ask a friend or family member to act as the interviewer. Keep your answers natural and honest.
