


For the SITS myHub authentication **Stay signed in** window, it will not make any difference whether you tick the **Don't show this again** box or select **Yes** or **No**.


Whether you initiate a new browser session or simply open additional tabs will determine if you are prompted for SSO/MFA authentication during subsequent myHub access.

<p>4.2</p>	<p>Returning Direct Applicants will not be challenged for SSO/MFA during their application process as this is completed using their original local SITS accounts</p>	
<p>4.3</p>	<p>Post Graduate Applicants will not be challenged for SSO/MFA during their application process as this uses this fast-track application form where user authentication is not required.</p>	

		
<p>4.4</p>	<p>UCAS Applicants will receive their AD credentials as normal (initially with limited access) and they will not be challenged for SSO/MFA until their SITS record has been applicant transferred (ATR'd) and they are invited to Online Registration. At which point they will then be challenged for SSO/MFA as per 3.1.</p>	<p>-</p>
<p>4.5</p>	<p>Agents applying on behalf of International Student will not be challenged for SSO/MFA as they use local SITS accounts. Later in the application process the actual student will be challenged for SSO/MFA once their account has been applicant transferred (ATR'd) and they are invited to Online Registration.
