



What will you study

In just two weeks you will become part of a tight-knit television production crew, producing on-location field segments and bringing them back to the exciting environment of the live television studio. You decide what type of programme, from entertainment to factual, documentary to sci-fi. You bring the ideas, and we'll give you the tools to make it happen.

Bournemouth University is home to two 4K television studios. You will get handson experience with vision mixers, pedestal cameras, camera control units, green screen, sound production and more, covering a range of management strategies and transferable skills from the creative industries and beyond.

- Become part of a television studio crew, generating content, and working in live production
