

Student Village - Arrivals briefing

Fire Safety

- If you discover a fire, dial 999 immediately and/or activate one of the red call points.
- If you hear a fire/smoke alarm, evacuate the building immediately
- Go straight to the assembly point
- Remain outside at the assembly point until told otherwise by BU staff or the fire brigade
- No Smoking
- No Candles
- No Incense
- Do not tamper with any fire safety equipment.

Smoking policy

All houses in the Student Village are smoke/vape free. If you do smoke/vape please do so outside and approx 5 metres away from the house(s) to avoid bothering others.

Drugs Policy

BU is unable to tolerate the use or sale of illegal drugs including all psychoactive substances (including those previously known as 'Legal Highs') covered under the Psychoactive Substances Act 2016. Use of these substances on BU property will result in eviction from your accommodation and could lead to expulsion from the University.

Alcohol on the street

It is an offence to consume alcohol in public areas in Bournemouth, including the grounds of the Student Village itself. Police checks are undertaken and penalties issued, so if you are going to drink alcohol we strongly recommend you keep this in mind.
