Is this the course for me?

Politics is constantly evolving and changing. In our digital age the media plays an increasingly important role in political elections, campaigns and conflicts all over the world.

On this course you'll develop a clear understanding of UK and international politics, gaining the critical and practical skills you need to engage in modern politics. Combining insights from economics, psychology, history and philosophy, you'll learn to evaluate politicians, political systems and organisations.

This course also examines the opportunities and challenges that come with doing politics in a hyper-mediated environment.

Duration and delivery:

3 years including a 6 – week placement (or 4 years including a minimum 30week placement) Full time

Entry requirements:

104 tariff points from 3 A-level, or equivalent qualifications

IELTS (Academic) 6.5 with minimum 6.0 in each component, or equivalent
