



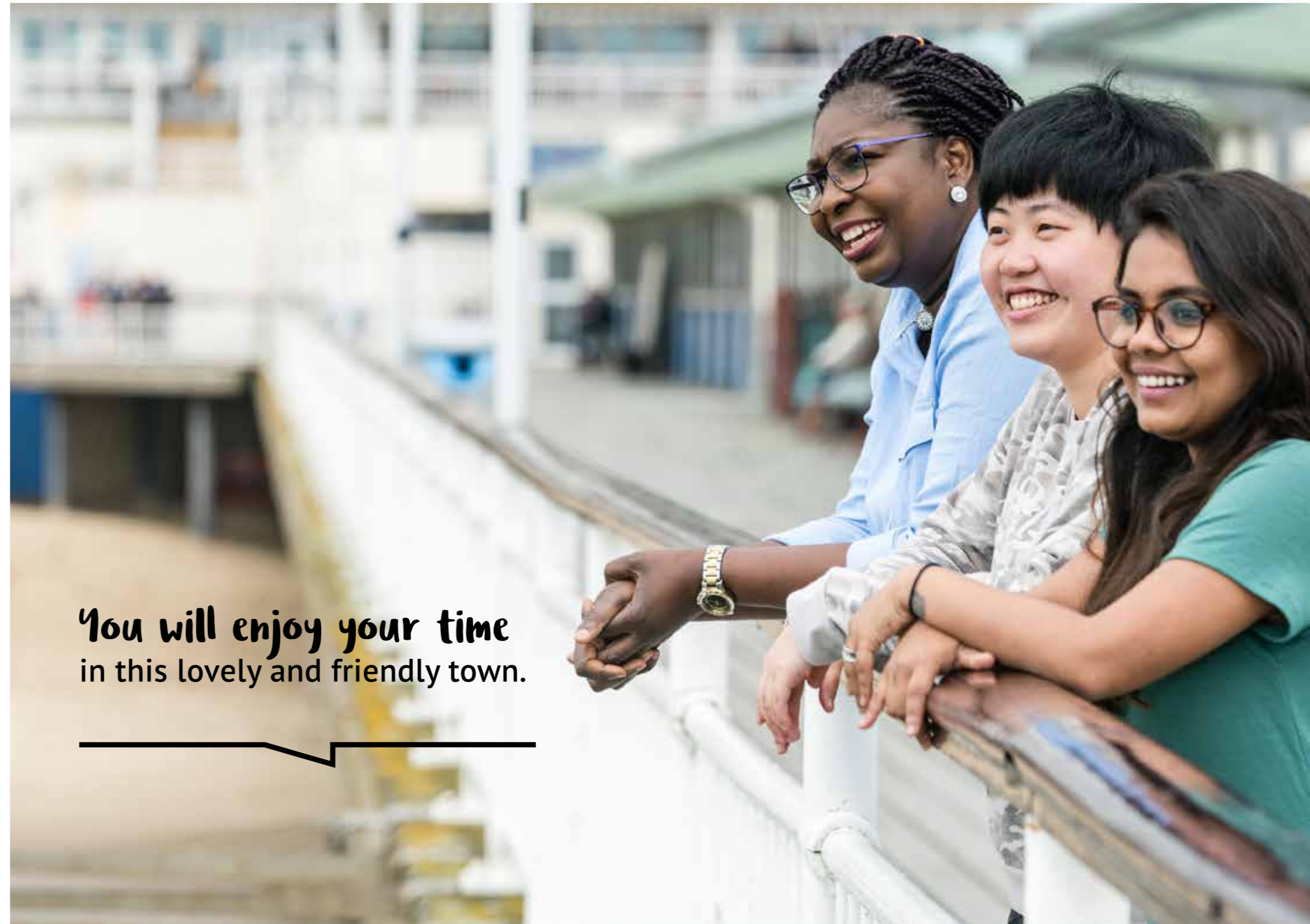

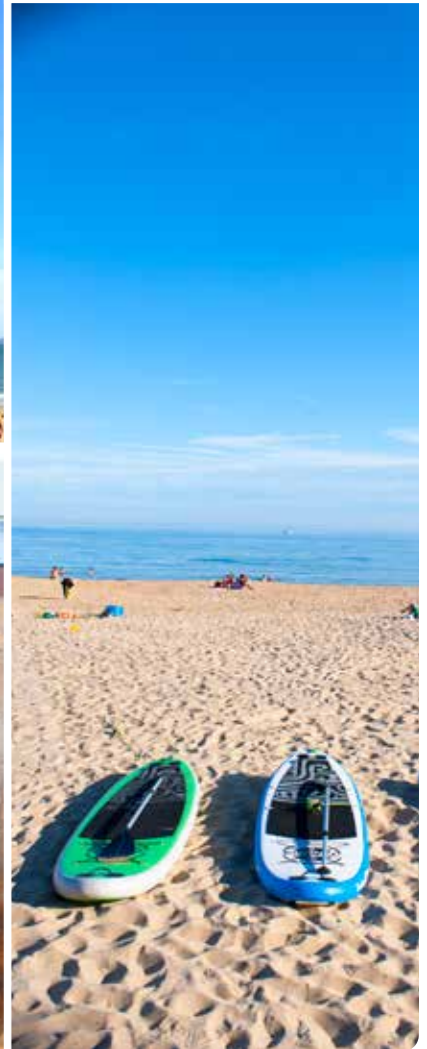
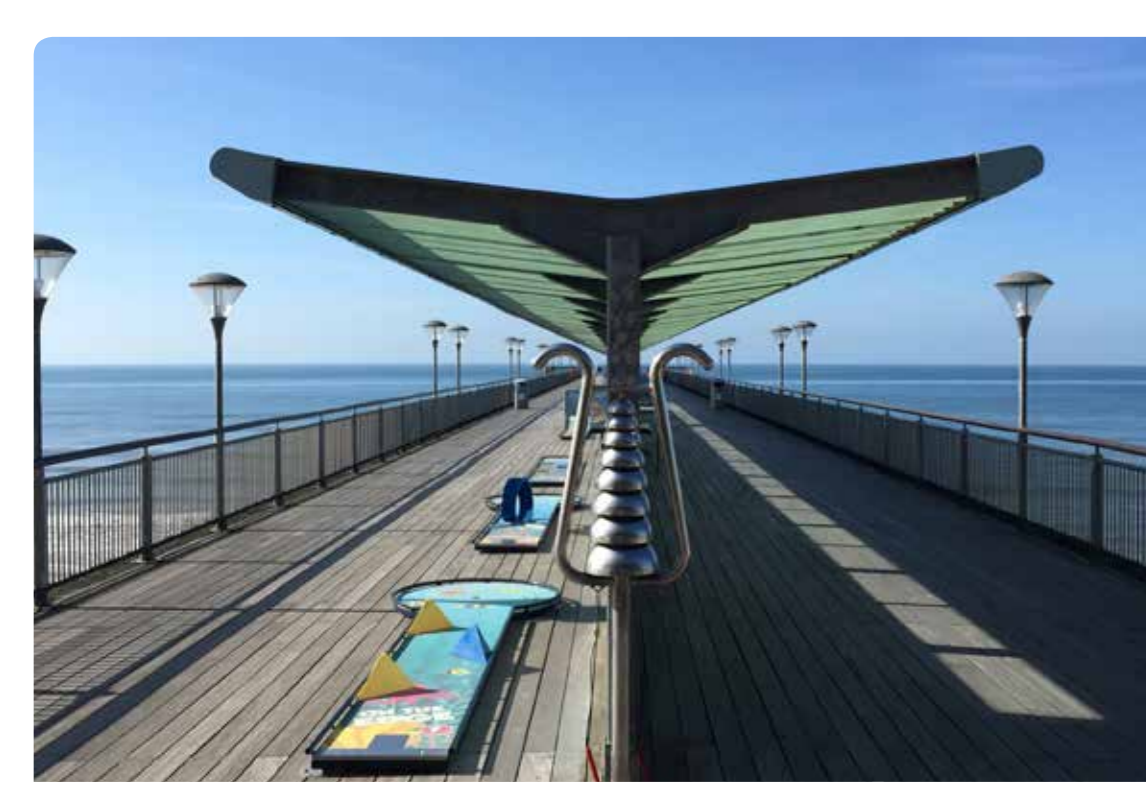

The Odeon Cinema is a great place to get away from reality. It's very modern and comfortable, with a lot of restaurants nearby giving you plenty of choice.







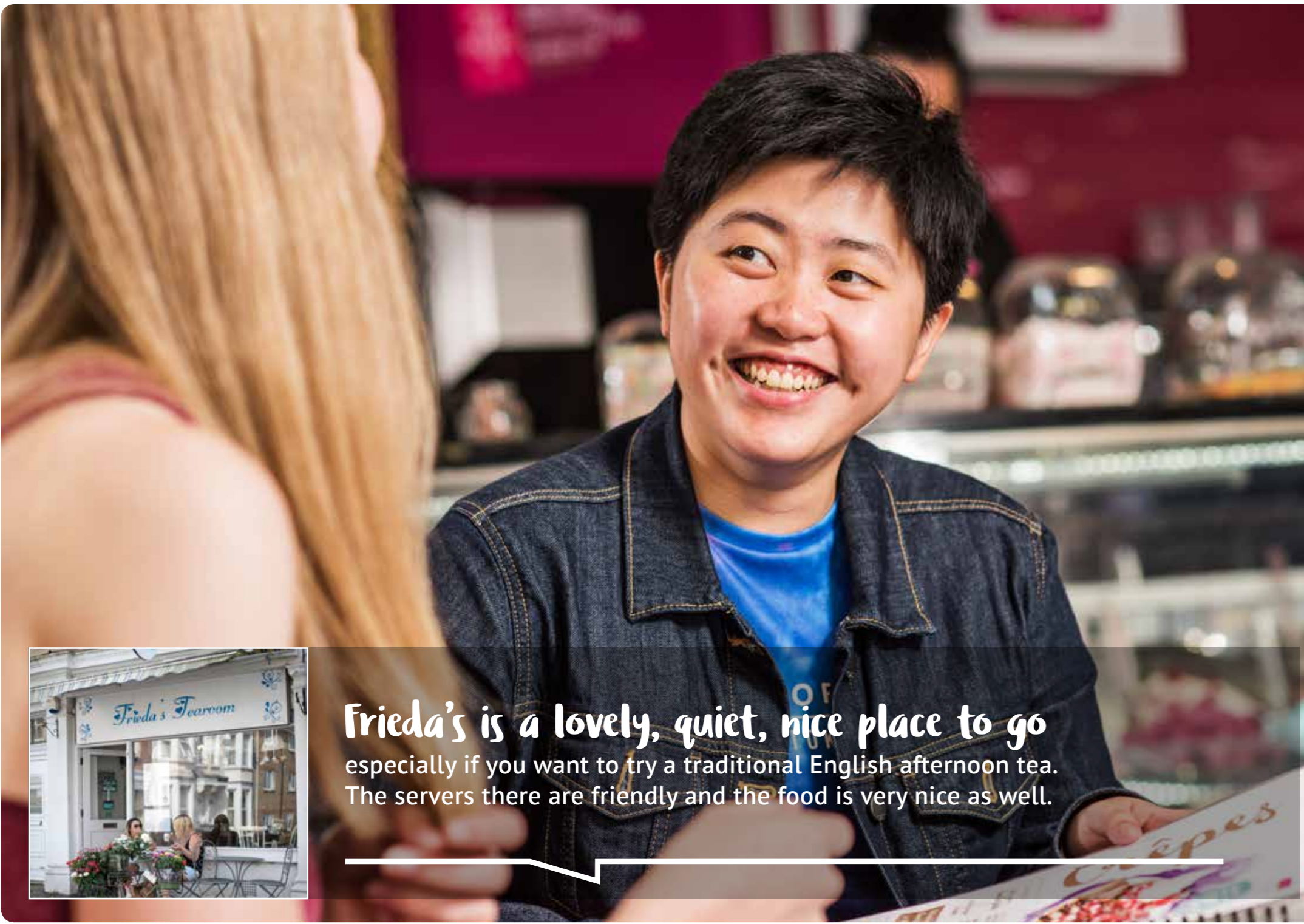
Great food, good-sized portions with a fast and friendly service. The Noodle Bar does some great deals as well. For example, it's buy one get one free on Mondays!





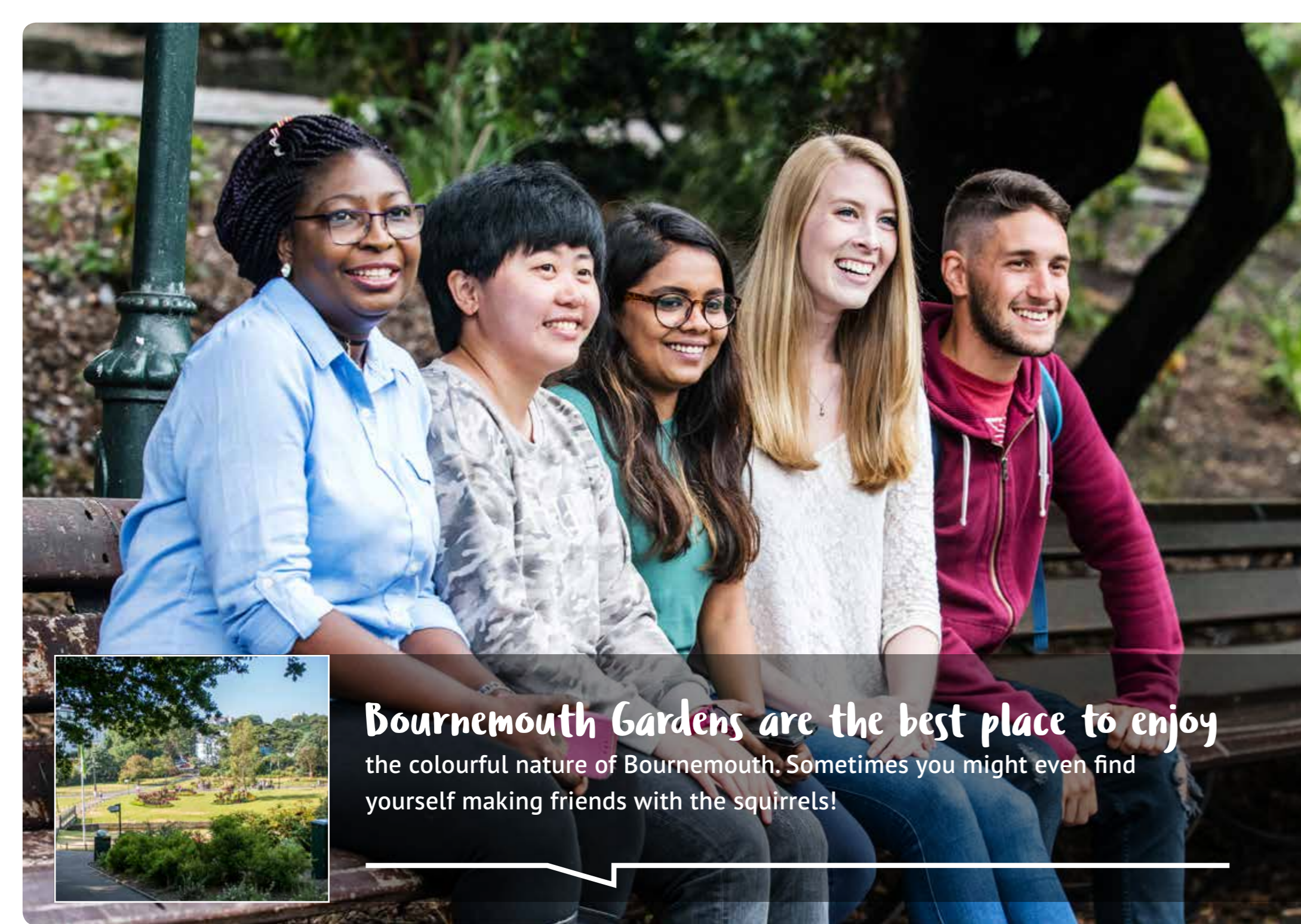
Sharkey's is a place to play snooker, ping-pong and watch live sport. It's a fun place that's ideal for hanging out with friends.





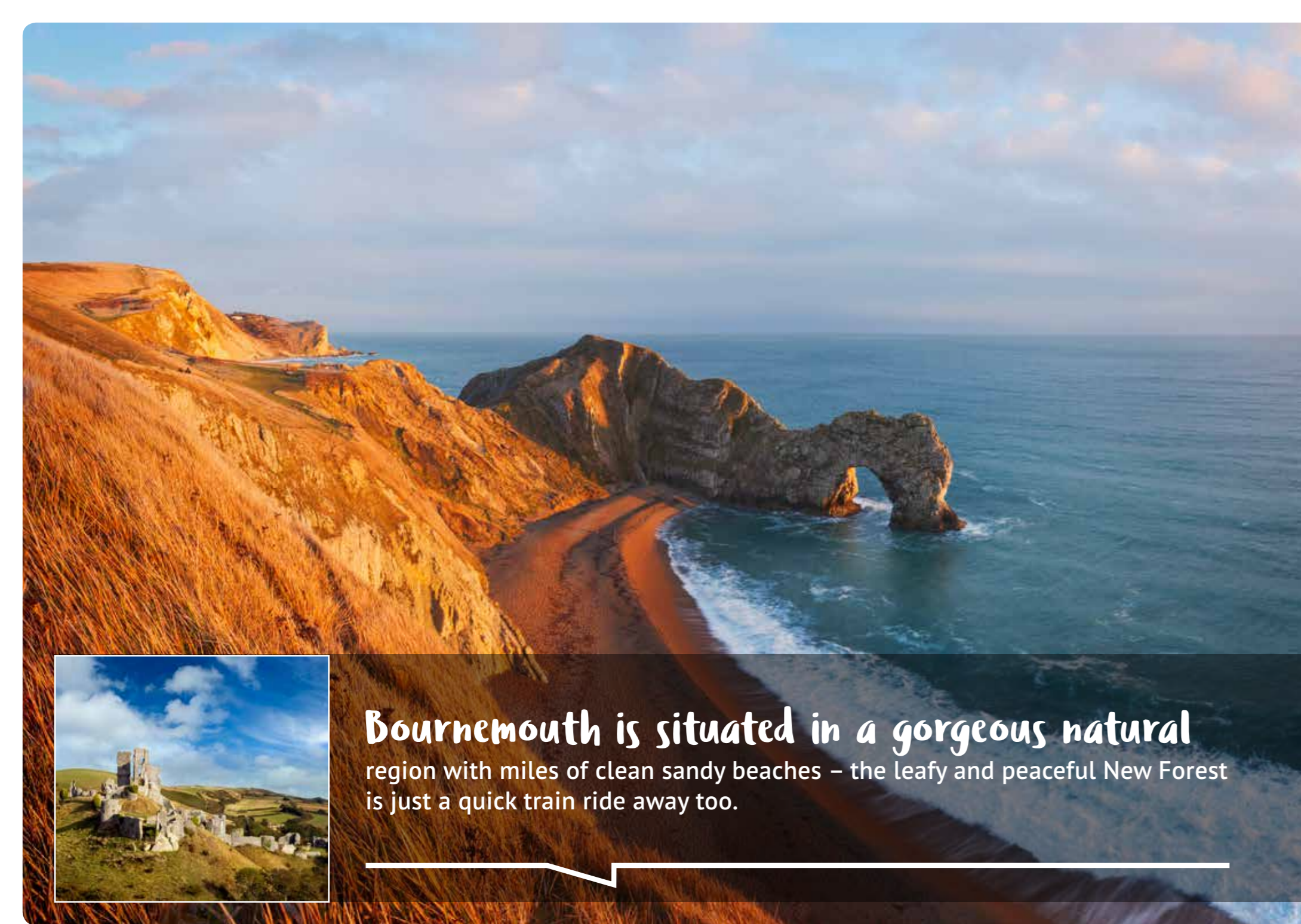
Frieda's is a lovely, quiet, nice place to go especially if you want to try a traditional English afternoon tea. The servers there are friendly and the food is very nice as well.



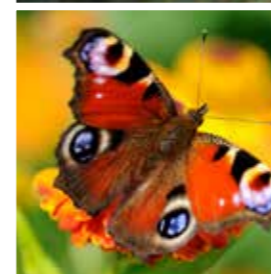


Bournemouth Gardens are the best place to enjoy the colourful nature of Bournemouth. Sometimes you might even find yourself making friends with the squirrels!
