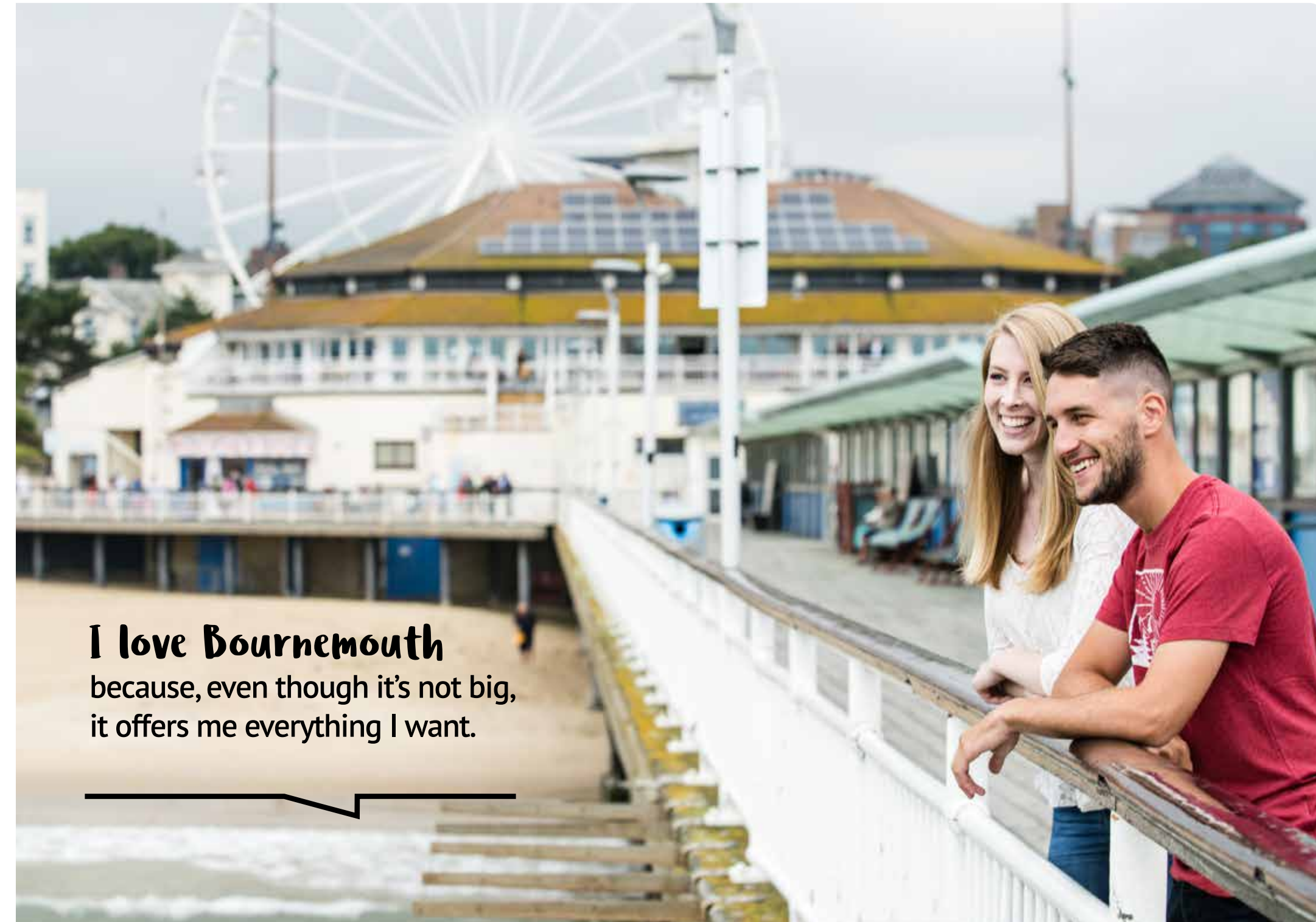


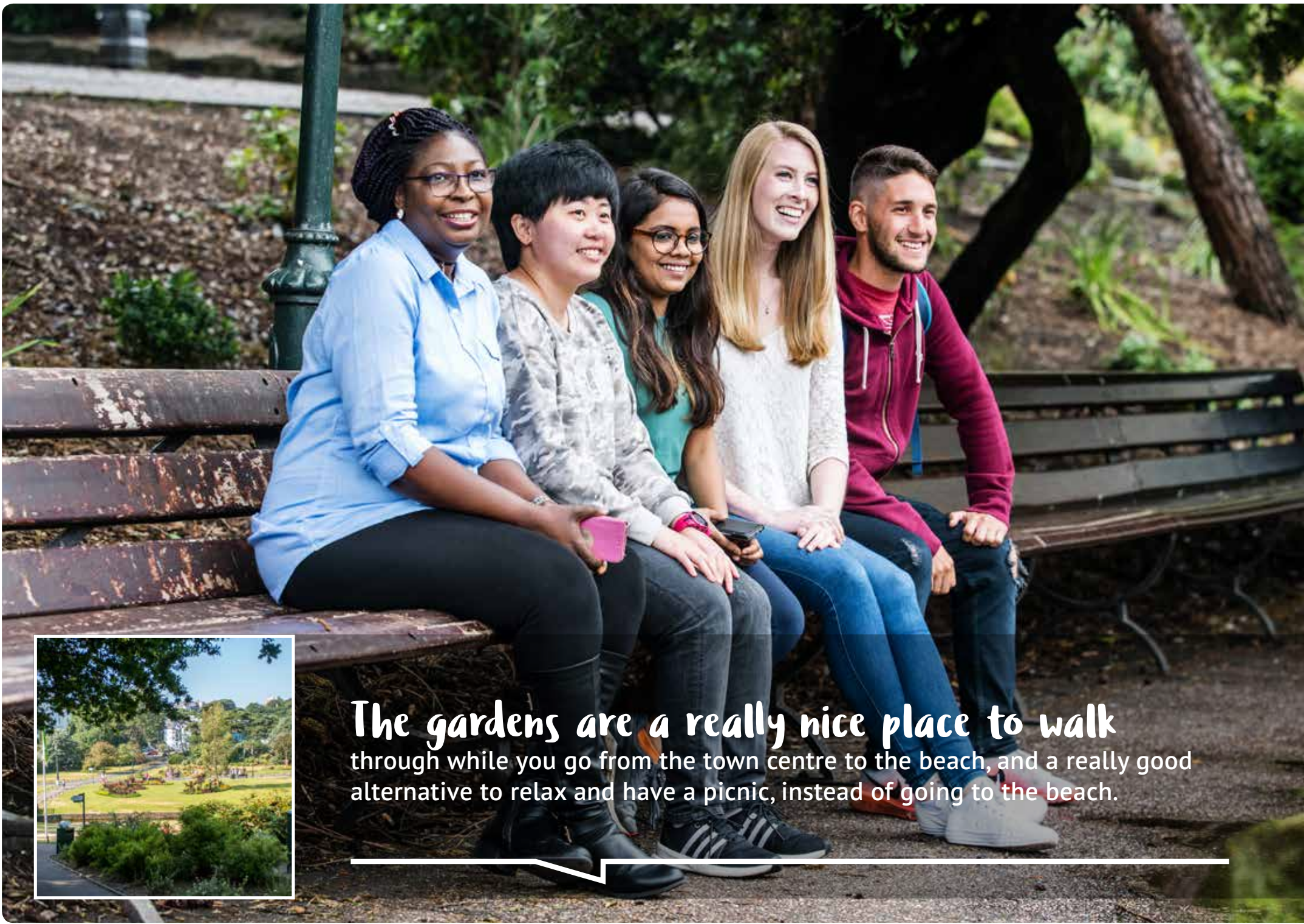

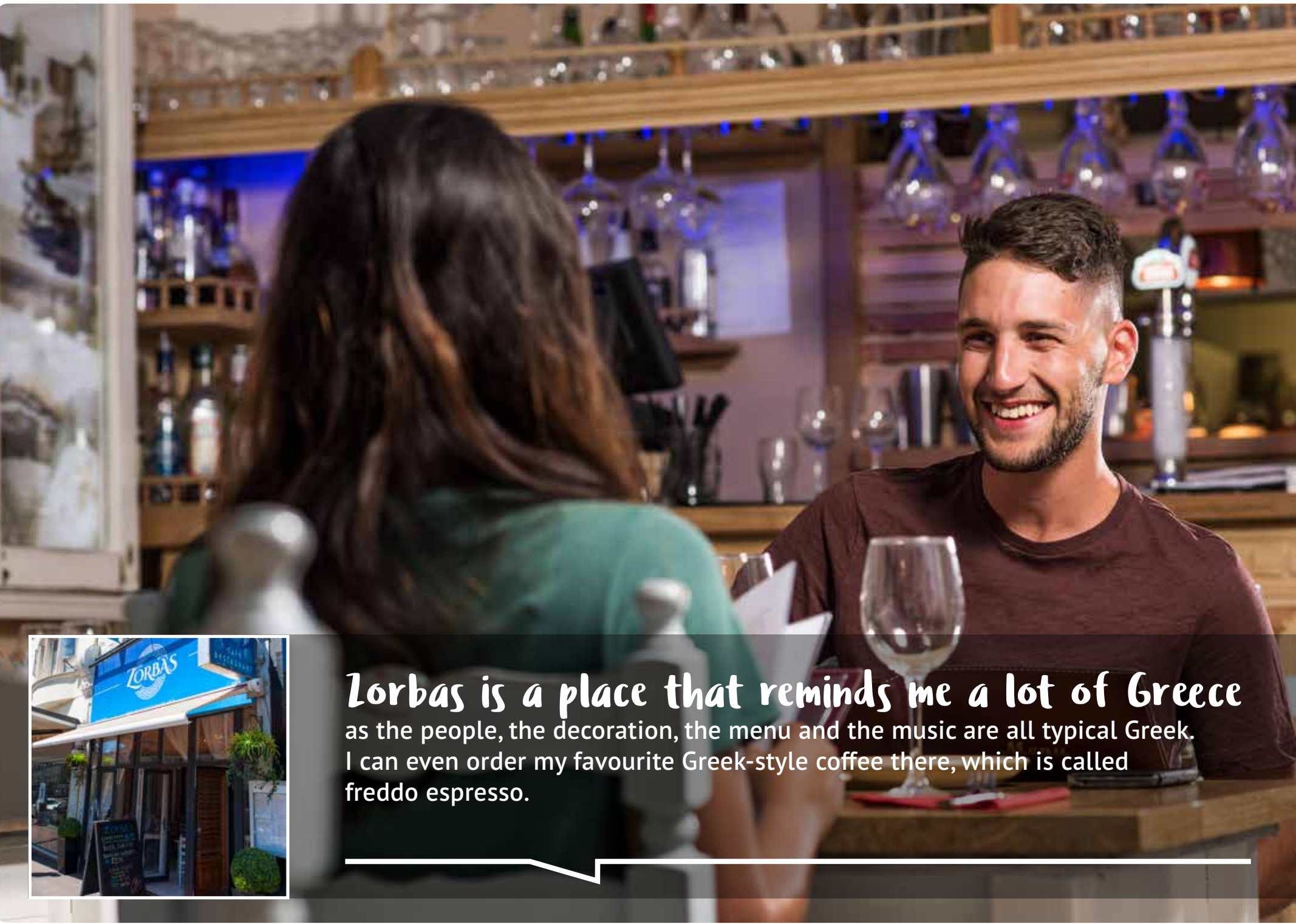
Hi! I'm John,

freddo espresso.






What I like about Bournemouth town centre
is that you can find everything you need in a really short distance. You can walk between places like restaurants, coffee shops, department stores and the cinema, all within ten minutes.



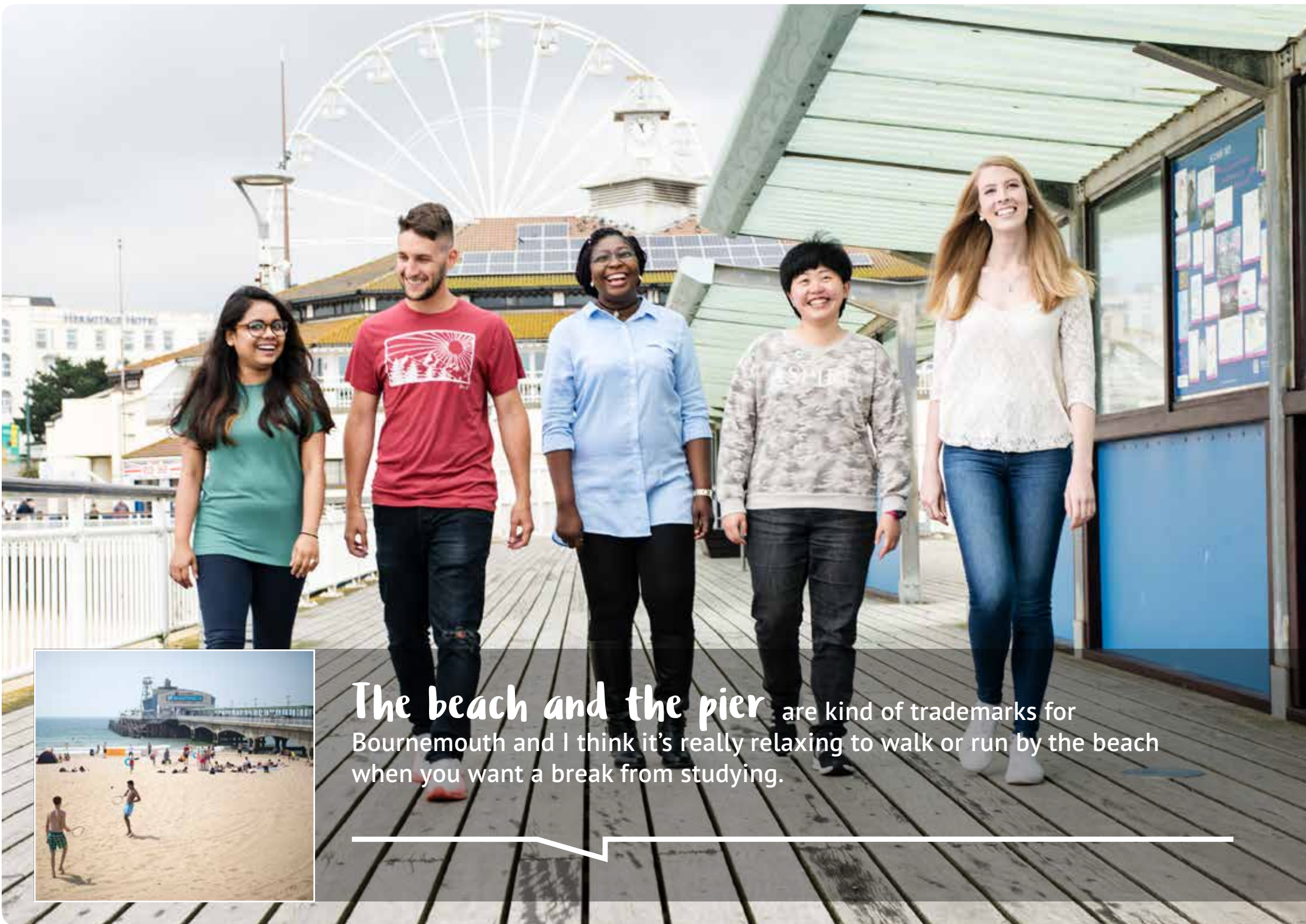


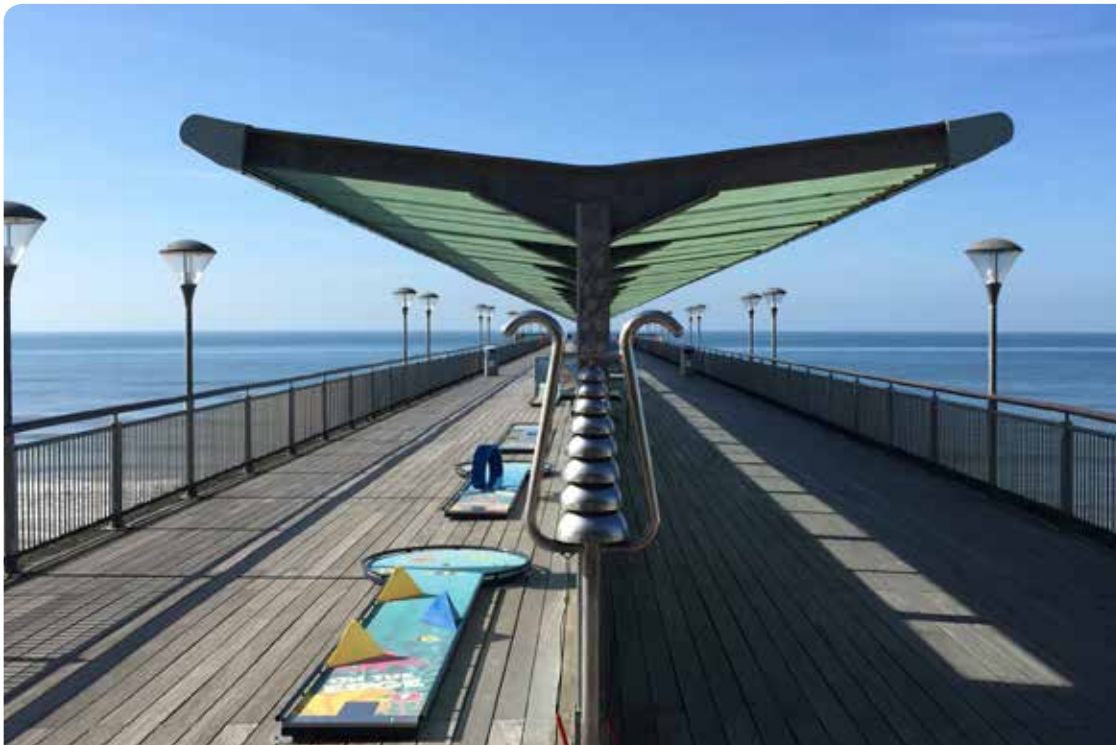


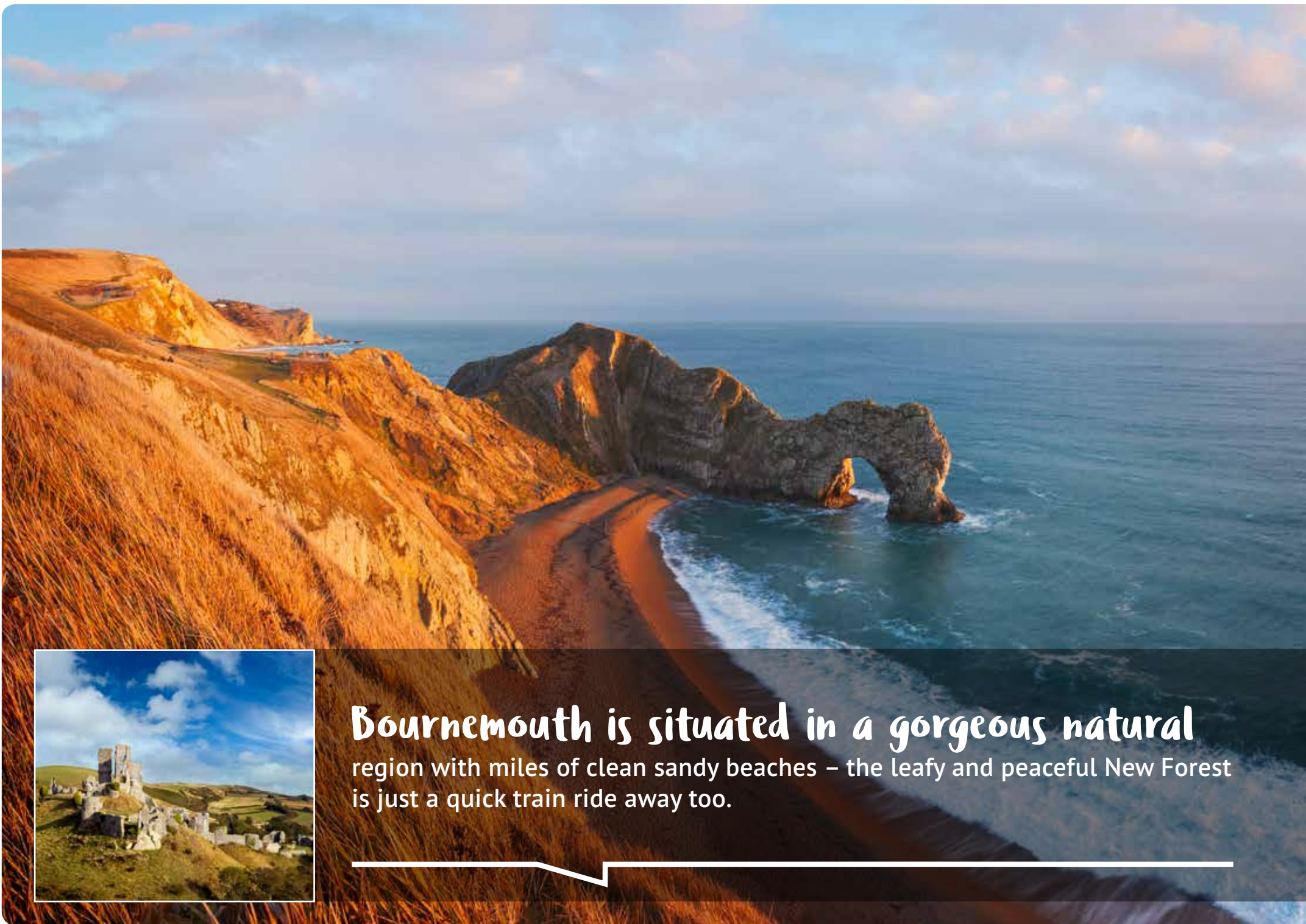
I like Aruba because it has one of the best views of the beach. The music, food and drinks are really nice and everyone knows it, so I often come here with friends (and there's student discounts too).



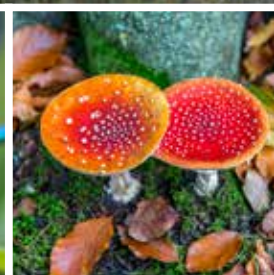









Bournemouth is situated in a gorgeous natural region with miles of clean sandy beaches – the leafy and peaceful New Forest is just a quick train ride away too.
