

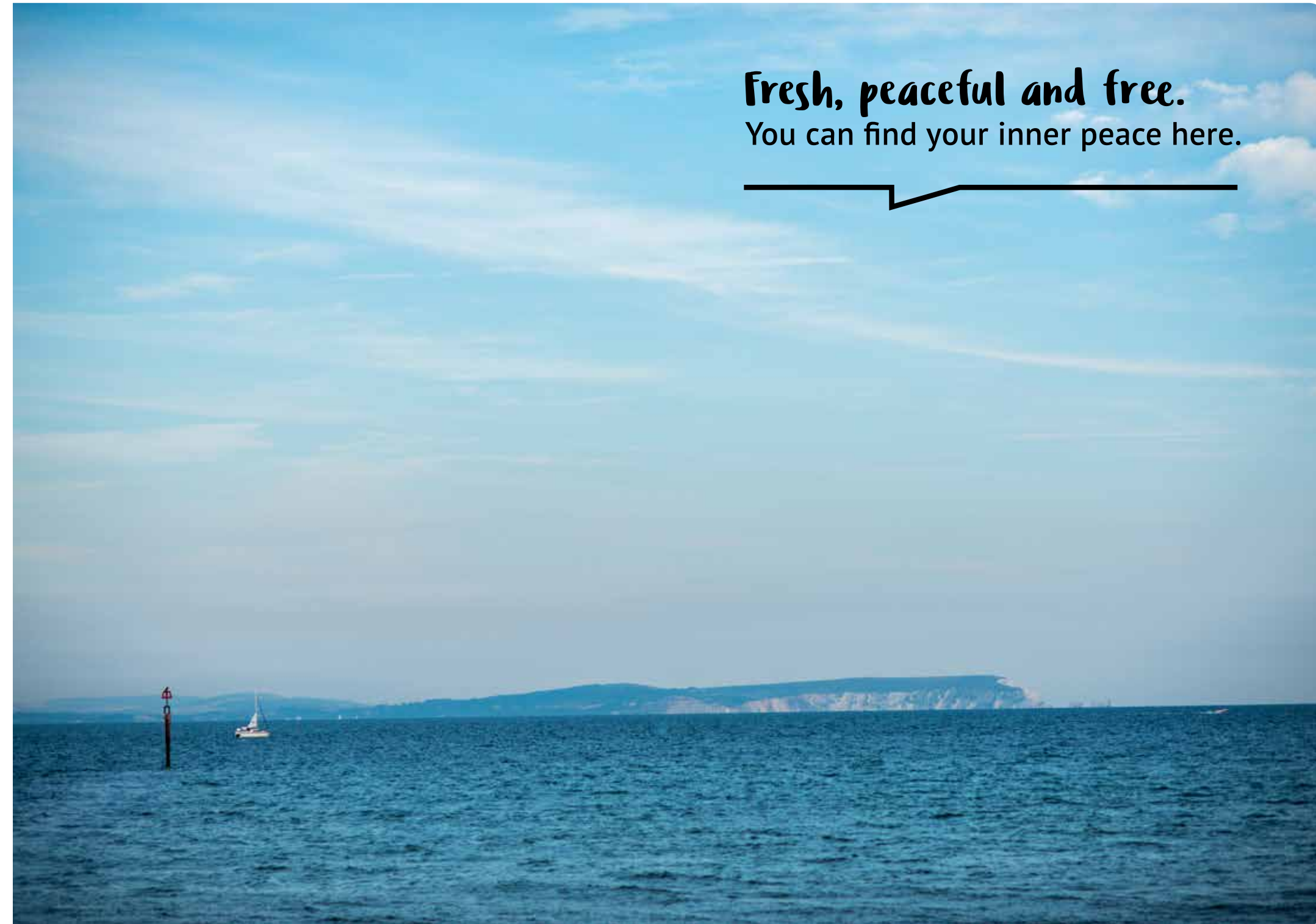



I can spend leisure time at the beach in a T-shirt and shorts walking barefoot in the sand. For me, it is exactly happiness and inner peace.







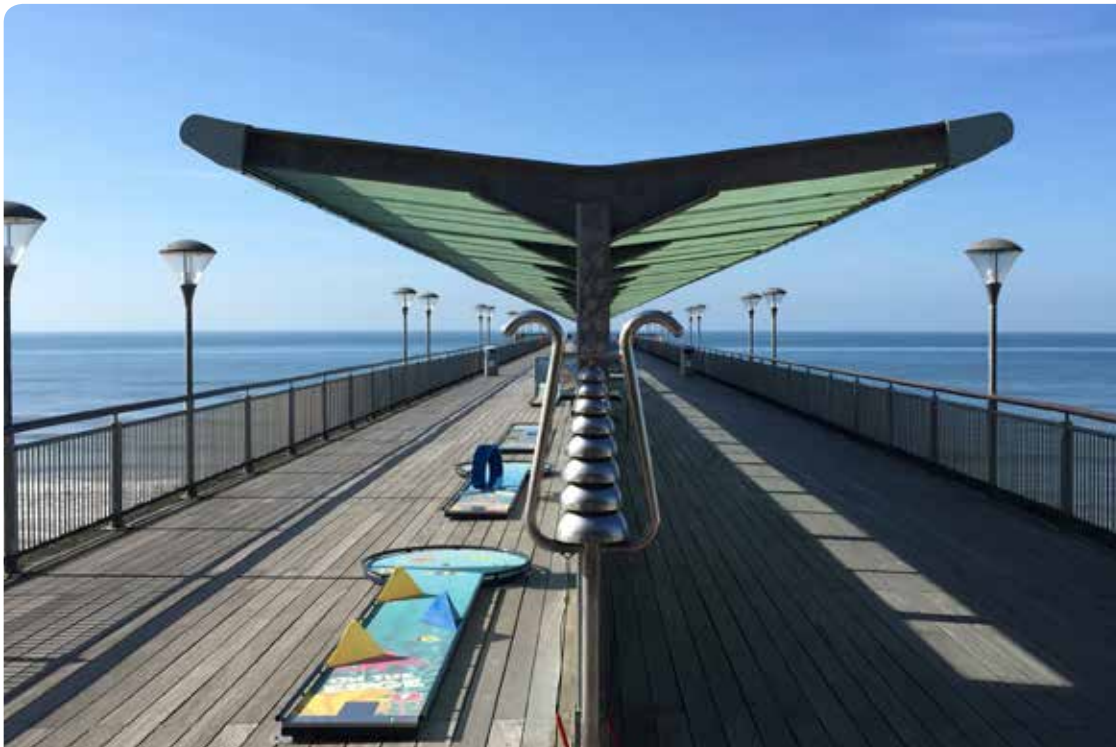

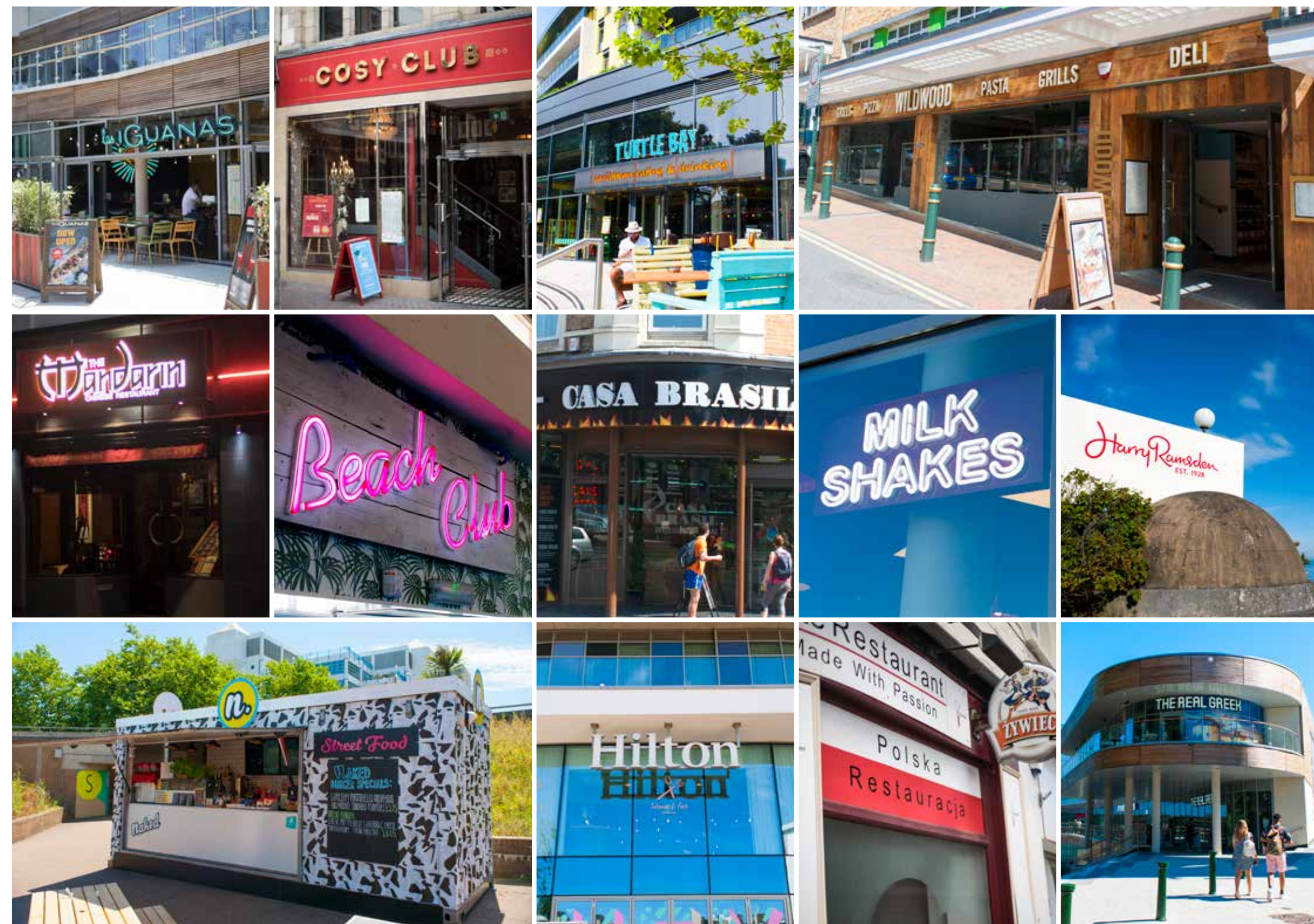

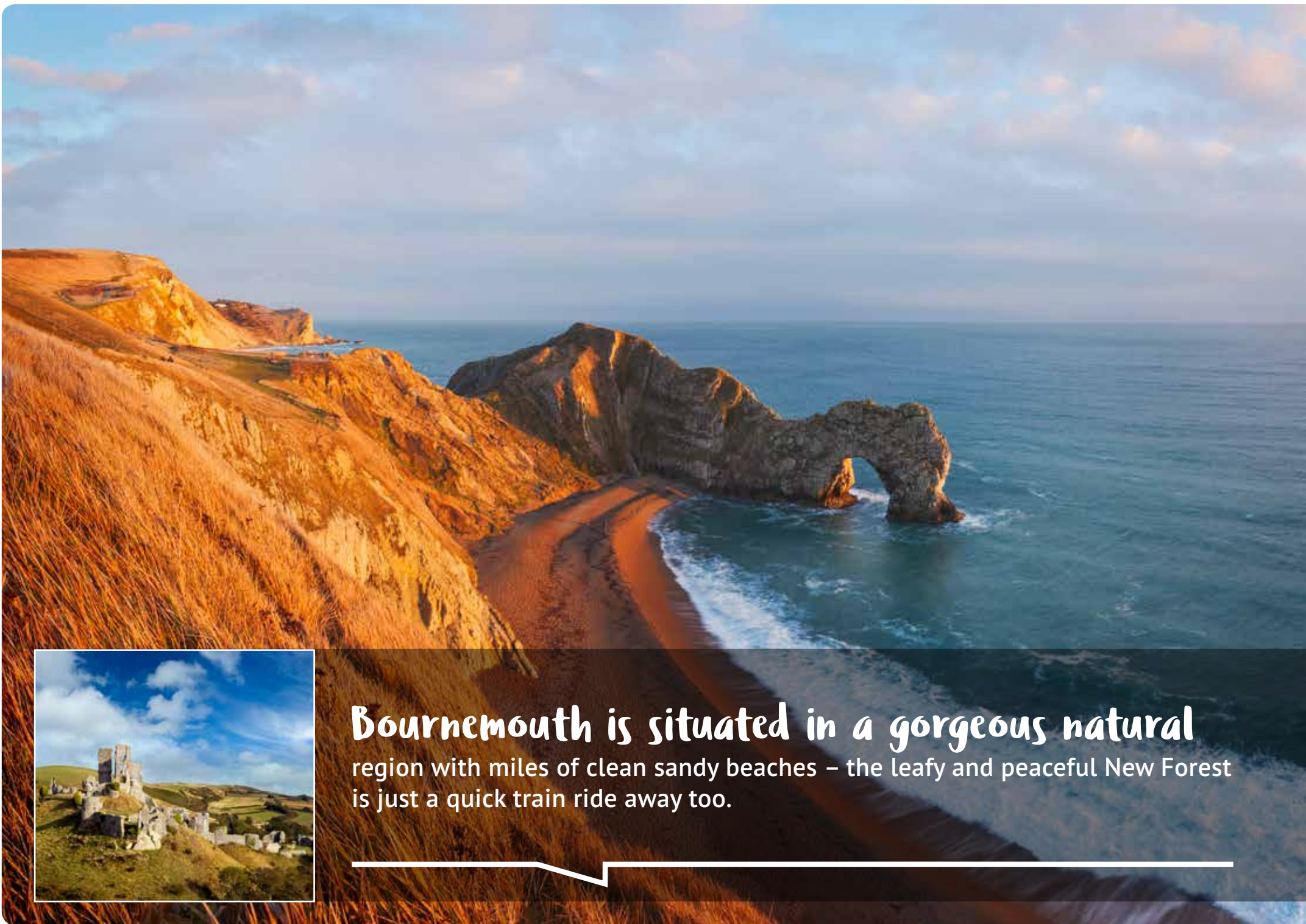
